
TRAINING AND COACHING ACTIVITIES

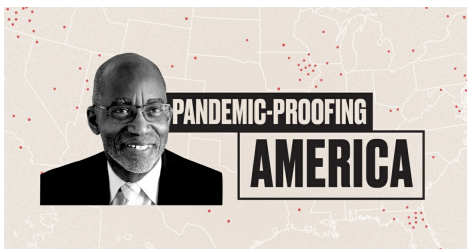
